**10:00 a.m. Driving Ring**

Any size equine which is safe to drive is welcome to try and to compete in all the obstacle classes. Specific rules and maps will be provided upon registration. Please note: classes may not run in the order listed here.

**Line Driving Obstacles**

Competitors ground drive their horses through a series of obstacles for best time. No vehicles allowed.

**Gamblers Choice**

Drivers are allowed 2 minutes to accumulate points by completing various obstacles a maximum of two times each.

**Pick Your Route**

Competitors can choose their order of driving through each of ten obstacles (pairs of cones) in this timed event.

**Double Jeopardy**

Two drivers with one turnout must complete the numbered course for best time.

**Clover Leaf Relay**

Set up for teams of two driving partners, each with their own horse and vehicle, driving a prescribed cloverleaf pattern around barrels twice, in relay format.

**Age Groups:**

**Tiny Tot** – age 10 and under

**Junior** – age 11-19

**Senior** – age 20 and over

**Participant Requirements:**

- Helmets for 18 yrs and younger
- Approved riding footwear
- Coggins original and copy for staff to keep
- Dogs should be leashed
